

SCHOLARSHIPS**

Scholarships are available to all students from the Las Vegas area who are graduating seniors applying to the University of Hawai'i System or are presently students in the University of Hawai'i System. Scholarship recipients must be full-time students. Applications must be received by the Scholarship Committee by 30 April. Students who are children or grandchildren of members of the Las Vegas Chapter applying to the University of Hawai'i System are particularly welcomed.

Candidates may apply for a scholarship as long as they provide the appropriate forms.

**Scholarship Requirements:**

1. A minimum (unweighted) GPA of 2.80 for the entire high school career (based on a 4.0 scale).
2. Must enclose a copy of an official transcript.
3. Three letters of recommendation from individuals not related to you and who are in good standing in the community.
4. Letter from the applicant summarizing reasons for applying, why deserving of scholarship, and how aid will be utilized.
5. High school seniors must have a letter of acceptance from the University of Hawai'i System.
6. Scholarship applicants who are reapplying must have maintained a 2.75 GPA (on a 4.0 scale) and be a full-time student. Letters of recommendation (No. 3) are not needed but a letter from the applicant is needed, accompanied with an official transcript.
7. The applicant must provide "PARENT/GUARDIAN FINANCIAL DATA"
