- COPYING FROM ANOTHER'S HOMEWORK
- ALLOWING COPYING OF YOUR HOMEWORK
- SUBMITTING ANOTHER'S WORK AS YOUR OWN
- PLAGIARIZING ANOTHER'S WORDS OR IDEAS
- GAINING ANY ACADEMIC ADVANTAGE IN A DISHONEST WAY



PERSONAL INTEGRITY

Think of *integrity* as *strength under pressure*. Pressure can be temptation for dishonest gain and easily rationalized when "everybody's doing it." Resist this pressure, and you'll be better off in the long run and a better influence on others.
