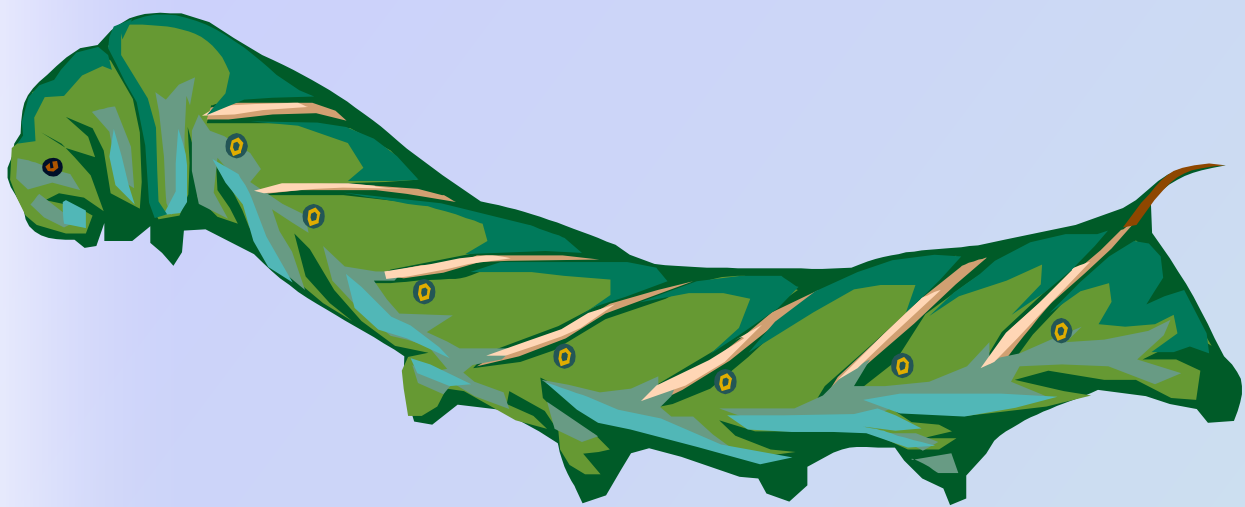


# Metamorphoses

## *WHAT ARE THE LIMITS OF LOGIC?*

### *1. IS TO OUGHT*

Can we LOGICALLY move from a statement of fact (what *is*) to a statement of moral value (what *ought* to be), or must we rely on fallible human judgment?

### *2. NON-LIVING TO LIVING*

At what point does non-living material become living? Can LOGIC alone explain this transformation?

### *3. MATERIAL TO NON-MATERIAL*

Can anything at all exist if it's not made of matter? How can we LOGICALLY understand the moment, if one exists, that matter transforms into an idea?

### *4. UNAWARE TO AWARE TO SELF-AWARE*

At what point does a being become aware of itself and its world? At what point does an aware being become aware that it's aware? Can LOGIC alone explain these transformations?
